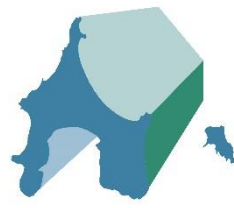

Now that we are in Alert Level 1, we can resume delivering the free financial training course to whanau. We have been in unprecedented times and have a "new" normal way of life.

We have delivered the free financial training course to 20 whanau. Some had an idea of their knowledge of financial capability going into the course, however, upon completion, all agree it has enhanced their understanding of becoming financially capable. All picking up useful tools to help them with their spending, saving, tackling debt, budgeting, preparing for the future (insurance, wills etc) and achieving their goals.

By completing this program (designed by the Commission for Financial Capability and Te Puni Kokiri), affordable housing packages will be available to whanau to apply for the proposed shared equity scheme with the Partnership Trust.

We are about to start the second cohort to a further 10 whanau. There are **Two available placements.**
